Annexure-II

The amount of Centre fees received by Examination Centres for conducting Practical examinations is to be disbursed by the Centres in the following manner:

- 10% of the total amount received by the Centre towards Overhead expenses
- 40% towards cost of conducting Practical (samples, materials, apparatus etc.).
- 25% towards refreshment of the examiners and other personnel & college staff involved in the Practical
- 12.5% towards Contingency expenses and 12.5% service charges to Non-Teaching staff.
