Processing Fee: INR 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred Only) for certificates, course material, etc. To be paid after selection only. Selected candidates will be intimated through email. The detailed payment link will be given in the selection mail only.

Mode of teaching: Entire process of teaching, learning, and evaluation for the programme will be conducted through online platforms on Saturdays/Sundays/holidays or weekdays after the normal working hours (evening).

Faculty: The programme modules will be taught by experienced faculty members (teachers) of different academic institutes and industries situated in India and abroad.

Intake Capacity: Maximum intake capacity is 70. With a minimum cut-off number of 50 candidates. Candidates will be selected on a first come first serve basis.

Programme Structure:

- Module I: Soft Skill
- Module II: Computer Application

Mode of Evaluation: The evaluation process will be carried out throughout the programme duration by a combination of the following methods.

- Performance throughout the programme (20% weightage).
- Project work (30% weightage).

• Objective assessment (50% weightage).
